
PROHIBITING PLAYERS & RECORDING DEVICES

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

CAE is committed to achieving the highest level of safety by meeting or surpassing regulatory requirements, by auditing the safety implications of our activities, by identifying areas for improvement through incident reporting, investigation and risk assessment, and by encouraging the open and honest reporting of safety issues.

POLICY:

Due to the hazards and risks that may increase liability or potentially harm the company, if audio and video equipment were to be operated on the tarmac or inside the aircraft, it is necessary for the company to take responsibility for such practices and eliminate the risk and distractions that such situations present to organizational assets and/or property.

Therefore, the CAE Global Academies shall immediately prohibit the use of audio, video and camera players and recording devices on the tarmac and in the aircraft by all flight crew personnel. In contrast, company-provided or other players or recording devices that may be hard-wired and/or permanently installed in the aircraft are still authorized for continued use. Additionally, personal mobile phone/communications devices may continue to be carried on the tarmac and aboard aircraft with the exception that they shall only be used for contacting emergency services or on the ground while not located in the aircraft or on the tarmac.

The Center Manager and/or Head of Training or Chief Flight Instructor may make exemptions to the policy outlined here-in on a per flight basis.

EXCEPTIONS AND REVIEW:

This policy shall be reviewed periodically by the Chief Safety Officer and the Vice President of Pilot Provisioning.
