

Attention Students and Instructors:

October 31, 2016

Falcon Field will be undergoing construction over the next 90 days to accomplish the following objectives:

- Install blast pads on the ends of 4L/22R
- Re-align taxiway Charlie to mirror taxiway Alpha with a holding bay.
- Re-design the 4R runup area to new FAA standards.

During this construction 4L/22R is expected to be closed from October 31<sup>st</sup> to November 23<sup>rd</sup>. Runway 4R/22L will be closed from November 28<sup>th</sup> to December 19<sup>th</sup>. These dates are subject to change.

**During single runway operations, pattern work is prohibited unless authorized by Tower.** Pattern work may be authorized by Tower on a workload permitting basis only. Please be sensitive to the Tower's needs. If you are conducting pattern work and the pattern begins to become congested, change to a full stop or go somewhere else. Overloaded airspace and frequency congestion causes an increased risk of runway incursions, pilot deviations, controller deviations, and mid-air collisions.

If the pattern becomes busy, and Tower is not able to handle your request for a landing, they may tell you to remain outside the Class Delta, or they will not respond to you after multiple attempts. In this case, it is recommended to circumnavigate the Class D to the North. While doing so, monitor Falcon Tower and await further instructions when tower workload allows. If you happen to fly into NE practice area without receiving a call back from Tower, hold in the vicinity of the Fountain Arrival and use caution for other traffic. Be mindful of altitude restrictions such as the Class Bravo.


