

KFFZ Open House Restrictions

Effective March 24, 2018

Background:

CAE OAA is committed to achieving the highest level of safety by meeting or surpassing regulatory requirements, by auditing the safety implications of our activities, by identifying areas for improvement through incident reporting, investigation and risk assessment, and by encouraging the open and honest reporting of safety issues. Added risk from Falcon Field Airport's "Open House" event requires mitigation which is being distributed through this communication.

Abbreviations and Definitions:

Falcon Field Open House – Event hosted by Falcon Field Airport, open to the public showcasing a static display of aircraft, UAV's, Model Railroads, and custom automobiles. The event runs Saturday March 24th from 0900 to 1400 local time.

Policy:

1. **The 22L runup area is to be used for runups by all CAE aircraft on Saturday March 24th, between 0600 and 1800 local time (or whenever the 4R runup area is re-opened following the event).**
2. **The taxi flow through the CAE ramp will be towards the 22L runup area during this time.**
3. **No student solo pattern-work between 0600 and 1600.**

Important Notes:

- CAE Flight crews should taxi through the ramp and call Ground at Spot 6. Ground will then instruct you to taxi to the 22L runup area. Please keep in mind that this does not give you authorization to taxi onto Taxiway Delta. Inform Ground when "runup complete" and they will issue you taxi instructions to the runway in use. PAY VERY CLOSE ATTENTION TO TAXI INSTRUCTIONS. It is possible you may receive instructions to hold on the taxiway if helicopter operations are occurring near taxiway Delta.
- All aircrews please use caution for rotorwash from 4 helicopters who will be giving rides during the event, as well as multiple medivac helicopters which will be based at the event.
- Several small vintage aircraft will be giving rides occasionally as well.
- Between 1100 and 1115 local time, a formation fly-by will occur. The KFFZ Tower is not closing the airspace during the fly-by, but aircraft may find themselves holding in the airspace during that time.
- While dual pattern-work is not restricted during the event, please be sensitive to airspace congestion.

Exceptions and Review:

The above policies apply to all CAE Operations at KFFZ during designated times stated above.
