Requirements For Certificates, Ratings & Authorizations Valid pilot or student pilot certificate issued under FAR 61; photo identification such as passport or driver's license; Medical Certificate (may be combined with student pilot certificate); Ref: 61.3(a), (c)

Certificates & Ratings Certificates: Student Pilot, Private Pilot, Ratings (Private Pilot or above): Airplane Single Engine Land, Airplane Multi Land
Ref 61.5(a)

Duration of Certificates Student Pilot: 24 months

Pilot Logbooks- Training Time & Aeronautical Experience Document and record, in a manner acceptable to Administrator, aeronautical experience (and training) used to meet requirements;
Ref: 61.51 (a)

Logbook Entries Information required: date, total flight or lesson time, location of departure and arrival airports or location of simulator or training device, type and identification of aircraft or simulator, name of safety pilot if required, type of pilot experience or training (solo, PIC, SIC, flight or ground training, simulator or FTD training), conditions of flight (day, night, actual or simulated instrument) Ref: 61.51(b)

Logging Training Time Training time received from an Authorized Instructor in aircraft, flight simulator or flight training device; authorized instructor must be endorse in legible manner; include description of training given, length of training and authorized instructor's signature, certificate number, and expiration date Ref: 61.51(h)

Presentation of Required Documents Must present pilot certificate, medical certificate, or logbook upon reasonable request by FAA, NTSB, Federal State or Loca law enforcement; Student Pilots must carry in the aircraft- pilot logbook, Student Pilot Certificate, any other required records Ref: 61.51(i)
